NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

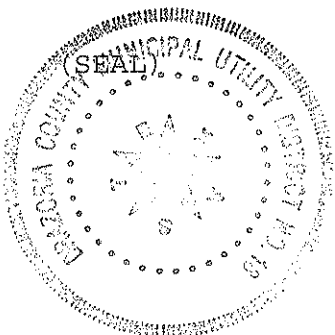
Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at City of Pearland Public Library, 3522 Liberty Drive, Pearland, Brazoria County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 27, 2007, at 6:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Review and approve the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on January 30, 2007 (1 minute);
2. Consider comments from the public (5 minutes);
3. Consider bookkeeper's report (5 minutes), including:
 - a. Financial and investment reports, and the taking of any action required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented; and
 - b. Status of City of Pearland payment of water and sewer connection rebate;
4. Consider Tax Assessor-Collector Report (5 minutes), and the taking of any action required in connection therewith, including:
 - a. Authorizing the payment of disbursements presented; and
 - b. Taxpayer appeals;
5. Consider Engineering Report (5 minutes), including:
 - a. Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District, including:
 - i) Centennial Village Culvert Crossing; and
 - ii) Water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities to serve Villages of Towne Lake;
 - b. Status of construction of utilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders, including water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities to serve Villa d'Este, Section Two;

6. Consider status of or authorizing maintenance, modification and repair of detention ponds within the District, including (i) drainage study regarding detention ponds located within Pine Hollow, Pine Hollow Estates and Lawrence Place Subdivisions (ii) review and approval of revised Summary of Cost from Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc. for maintenance of same, (iii) status of inspection of facilities by Brazoria County Drainage District No. 4, and (iv) discussion regarding uniform maintenance plan for same and authorize appropriate action (15 minutes);
7. Consider the adoption of a Resolution regarding maintenance responsibilities of detention ponds (5 minutes);
8. Consider acceptance and/or conveyance of sites and acceptance and/or conveyance of facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including discussion regarding acceptance and conveyance of Drainage Reserve D in Bellavita at Green Tee, Section Five (5 minutes);
9. Consider Developers' Reports (5 minutes);
10. Consider attorney's report (5 minutes);
11. Consider approval of supplemental audit relative to the payment of bond proceeds in connection with impact fees, and authorize disbursement of bond proceeds in accordance therewith (5 minutes);
12. Discussion of renewal of District insurance coverages and consider approval of proposal for same (5 minutes);
13. Discussion regarding Amended and Restated Agreement for Legal Services between the District and Schwartz, Page & Harding, L.L.P. ("SPH") and authorize the taking of any action in connection therewith, including consider acceptance of resignation letter from SPH (15 minutes);
