 - (a) status of proposal for detention pond maintenance agreement with Brazoria Drainage District No. 4;
 - (b) status of Application for Approval of Project and Bonds;
 - (c) approve pay estimates and change orders, as necessary;
 - (d) authorize advertisement for bids as necessary;
7. Developers' reports;
8. Discuss guidelines for contributions to community improvement projects;
9. Discuss District name change;
10. Attorney's Report, including:
 - (a) ownership of Towne Lake pumping station;
 - (b) detention pond ownership;
11. Consider comments from non-district residents; and

12. Such other matters as may come before the Board.
